## The Creative Process

- Once you've selected your favorite image after your session, the creative process begins by studying your portrait to determine which color scheme will be most complimentary to the overall appearance.
- Once the colors have been established, modern hand-painting techniques are used to give your portrait it's one-of-a-kind artistic style.
- Second, the portrait is giclée printed onto premium Belgian Linen or Museum Matte Canvas using superior quality archival inks certified to last for many generations.
- Once the colors and tones in the giclée are thoroughly stabilized, your portrait is given a protective coating for durability.
- Next, professional oil colors are applied to the giclée using traditional painting methods giving your portrait it's timeless appearance.
- Once the oil paints have completely dried, an acrylic UV coating is brushed onto your portrait for added depth and protection from dust and harmful UV inhibitors.
- Our portraits have a guaranteed a life of 80 plus years to allow your family to enjoy your portraits for many generations!
